Description of Awards

Art Awards

The Graduate School recognizes graduate students who distinguish themselves in the field of fine arts. Works are displayed during the Graduate Art Exhibition.

Barton Scholars

The Barton Scholarship is awarded to EMU graduates who have maintained at least a 3.5 undergraduate G.P.A. This scholarship fund was created with an endowment made by Miriam Bradley in memory of her parents, Dr. W.R. Barton and Mrs. Emma Barton.

Provost Medal for Excellence in Graduate Assistantship

The Provost Medal is presented annually to two graduate assistants who demonstrate outstanding commitment to the University through service or to scholarly/research activity. It was created to honor the memory of Provost Collins and his wife, Geri.

George Brower Phi Delta Kappa Scholarship Award

Educational Leadership student papers for the Graduate Research Fair are judged, and the three recipients with the highest scores are honored. The award is in memory of emeritus educational leadership faculty member, Dr. George Brower.

Graduate Dean's Award for Research Excellence

This award recognizes excellence in a particular graduate research project, culminating in the submission of a completed thesis, germane to the program of study. Awards are given both fall and winter semesters.

Graduate Faculty Advisor Award

This award was created by Graduate Council to honor, award, and encourage a faculty member whose dedication and commitment to excellence in graduate student advising and program coordination at Eastern Michigan University is outstanding.

Graduate Faculty Mentoring Award

Graduate Council annually honors a faculty mentor whose dedication and commitment to excellence in graduate education and mentoring has made a significant contribution to the quality of life and professional development of graduate students at EMU.

Graduate Research Fair Awards: Student papers are judged and recipients with the highest scores are honored.

King-Chavez-Parks Future Faculty Fellows

These awards are provided to increase the number of highly talented minority students pursuing full-time teaching careers in post-secondary institutions in the state of Michigan.

Phi Delta Kappa Scholarship Award

College of Education GRF student papers are judged, and the three recipients with the highest scores are honored.

Music Awards

The Graduate School recognizes graduate students in the Music Department who distinguish themselves in a musical performance competition.

Theatre Arts Awards

The Graduate School recognizes individuals who distinguish themselves in Theatre Arts as nominated by the Communication, Media, and Theatre Arts faculty.

University Fellowships

University Fellowship recognizes and encourages superior academic work at the graduate level and provide financial assistance for outstanding graduate students, whose cumulative undergraduate or graduate G.P.A. is 3.6 or higher.
