How to Avoid Barriers to Submitting a Proposal: Get Your Proposal Materials to ORDA Early!

Funding proposals and the rules surrounding them are often complex and make significant commitment of University resources. All proposals must be reviewed and approved prior to submitting by the Principal Investigator/Project Director's (an any Co-Is) unit head and dean. The ORDA director, once these approvals are obtained, can authorize the submission of the proposal.

This process takes time, so please be mindful of your responsibility to work with ORDA as early as possible in the process. Per divisional policy, ORDA requires that all proposal materials be submitted for review three days in advance of the deadline.

Proposal approval is documented through the Cayuse SP, a sponsored project lifecycle management system, which includes electronic review and approvals, as well as serving as the electronic repository of all proposal and award documents. Your ORDA pre-award officer can assist you with the preparation and routing of necessary Cayuse SP documents.
