PREFACE

The *Enrollment Report* is in its eighth edition with the publishing of this volume. This year's edition, however, shows a marked change in scope. Keeping in mind that the primary purpose of the *Enrollment Report* is to provide a longitudinal record of the University's headcount and student credit hour production, several sections not conforming to this purpose have been revised and published separately in new institutional reports. Namely,

- The section on "Higher Education in Michigan" is now included in the report, *State of Michigan Enrollment Report*.
- The section on "Degrees Conferred" is now included in the report, *Degree Recipient Analysis*.

This restructuring allows the *Enrollment Report* to be more focused in its presentation and less unwieldy in its use. Specifically, more information is now provided on

- The secondary terms, i.e., the winter, spring and summer terms
- Full-year equated students.

Hopefully, as needs arise, further refinements and additions may be made. Note should also be taken of a considerable effort made to ensure consistency with other documents, such as the *Faculty Plan*, the *Department Profile*, etc. In any instances, however, where this edition does not agree with prior editions, all prior editions are superseded.

*** HIGHLIGHTS ***

I HEADCOUNT

Public High School Enrollment

- The number of Michigan public high school graduates fell to a record low of 101,948 graduates -- down 4.0 percent from the prior year and 21.9 percent from 1980.
- Eastern Michigan's market share of these graduates has plateaued at approximately 2.27 percent.

Application to Eastern Michigan

- The institution of an application fee caused a marked decline in the number of fall term applications received -- down by 26.0 percent.
- The secondary terms, i.e., winter, spring, and summer, were much less affected by the application fee.

Admittance to Eastern Michigan

- The number of fall term admittances fell sharply to 9,047, down by 2,853 admittances, or 24.0 percent. This represents the lowest such number since the fall term of 1985.
- The percentage of applicants admitted remained essentially unchanged. The application fee had no apparent effect on the percentage.
- The percentage of admittances enrolled also remained essentially unchanged.

New Fall Undergraduate Enrollments

- FTIAC enrollment fell to 2,234 students, down 229 students or 9.3 percent. The current FTIAC enrollment is the lowest since 1980.
- New fall term transfer enrollment remained strong at 2,033, falling only slightly from last year's record high. New transfers enrollment at upper class levels remains weak.

Returning Fall Student Enrollment

- Returning student enrollment grew markedly to a record high of 15,019 students, up by 1,167 students or 8.4 percent.
- All class levels shared in the growth of returning student enrollment.
- Undergraduate enrollments rose to a record high of 19,406, up by 888 students or 4.8 percent. Since 1980, these enrollments have increased nearly 40 percent.
- While all class levels have increased enrollment, the senior class level shows the greatest gain.

Graduate Fall Enrollment

- Graduate enrollment increased moderately to 6,548 students, up by 108 students or 1.7 percent.
- Graduate enrollments peaked in the fall of 1987, and are now oscillated about a mean of 6,500 students.

Total Fall Enrollment

- The total fall term enrollment of 25,954 is the largest in the University's history. This represents an increase of 996 students, or 4.0 percent over last year's record high.

Part-time Fall Enrollments

- The percent of undergraduate students attending part-time reached a six-year low at 31.65 percent.
- Graduate part-time enrollments were at a seven-year low of 81.15 percent.

Evening Fall Enrollments

- Evening undergraduate enrollments are at their lowest level in at least the last ten years.
- Evening graduate enrollments fell slightly from last year's record high. It now stands at 61.14 percent.

Citizenship Distribution - Opening Fall Term

- Michigan undergraduates continue to comprise a high proportion of enrollments. Ohio citizenships have increased as a percent-of-total, while the percentage of foreign students has declined.
- Michigan students continue to constitute a high percentage of the graduate students, but the percentage-of-total for graduate foreign students has given way to increases in the percentage of Ohio and other non-Michigan states.

Retention -- Undergraduates

- The retention rate of undergraduates from fall-to-fall remains essentially unchanged at 66 percent, up one point from the prior year. The retention rate of full-time students is approximately 73% greater than that of part-time students.
- There is essentially no difference in the retention rate of students admitted as transfer as opposed to FTIACs.
- The retention rate of black students is 90% that of non-black students.

II. CREDIT HOUR PRODUCTION

Credit Hour Production by Term

- The fall term continued to increase its percentage-of-total fiscal year credit hours.
- The spring term is showing considerably greater growth than the summer term.

Credit Hour Loads - Fall Term

- Undergraduate credit hour loads increased slightly to 11.46 credit hours per student -- a five year high.
- Graduate credit hour production increased markedly to 4.82 credit hours per student -- a seven year high.

Full Year Equated Student

--By Course Level

- For 1989/90, the greatest growth in FYES occurred among lower (100 & 200) level courses (despite the greater growth in upper class level enrollments.)
- Graduate FYES, for the same year, fell moderately, by 8.6% to 1986/1987 levels.
- Overall, University FYES production is at a record level of 18,295.19, up nearly 30 percent from 1980-81.

--By College

- The College of Arts and Sciences accounted for 93 percent of the total increase in FYES production.
- The College of Education was the only College to record a decline, down only slightly, by 45 FYES.
- All other Colleges recorded modest gains.
