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## PREFACE

The *Enrollment Report* is in its tenth edition with the publishing of this volume. Beginning with the 1990-91 edition, however, there was a marked change in scope. Whereas the primary purpose of the *Enrollment Report* is to provide a longitudinal record of the University's headcount and student credit hour production, several sections not conforming to this purpose have been revised and published separately in new institutional reports. Namely,

- The section on "Higher Education in Michigan" is now included in the report, *State of Michigan Enrollment Report*.
- The section on "Degrees Conferred" is now included in the report, *Degree Recipient Analysis*.

This restructuring allows the *Enrollment Report* to be more focused in its presentation and less unwieldy in its use. Specifically, more information is now provided on

- The secondary terms, i.e., the winter, spring and summer terms
- Full-year equated students.

Beginning in 1990/91, graphs were included on a trial basis for a select number of tables. Little support or comments on the utility of the graphs were received. As a consequence, the graphs have been discontinued.

Hopefully, as needs arise, further refinements and additions may be made. Note should also be taken of a considerable effort made to ensure consistency with other documents, such as the *Faculty Plan*, the *Department Profile*, etc. In any instances, however, where this edition does not agree with prior editions, all prior editions are superseded.

\*\*\* HIGHLIGHTS \*\*\*

*The following highlights are for FY 91/92.  
The fall term highlighted is official record fall 1992.*

I HEADCOUNT

Public High School Enrollment (Reference: Table #1)

- The number of Michigan public high school graduates in 1991-92 fell to a record low of 88,220 graduates -- down 6.0 percent from the prior year and 29.1 percent from 1980.
- Eastern Michigan's market share of these graduates plateaued in 1987/88 at 2.26 percent and remains nearly unchanged from this level in the current year with 2.27 percent.

Application to Eastern Michigan (Reference: Table #2)

- The number of applications remained essentially unchanged with only a 0.1 percent increase to 10,952 applications: the second lowest count since fall 1981.
- The secondary terms, i.e., winter, spring, and summer, maintained a relatively stable percentage of the fall term applications.

Admittance to Eastern Michigan

- The number of fall term admittances fell to 8,709, down by 74 admittances, or 0.8 percent. This represents the lowest count since the fall term of 1985.
- The percentage of applicants admitted fell nominally to 86.40 percent, a 1.1 percent decrease from the prior year record high. The current year represents the second highest level on record.
- The percentage of admittances enrolled reached a seven-year high at 49.62 percent.

New Fall Undergraduate Enrollments (Reference: Table 3)

- FTIAC enrollment fell to 2,042 students, down 118 students or 5.4 percent. The current FTIAC enrollment is the lowest since fall 1979.
- As a percent of fiscal year FTIACs, the fall term FTIAC enrollment fell to 35.50 percent, the lowest since 1978.
- New fall term transfer enrollment grew sharply at 14 percent to a record 2,246, surpassing the 1989 record high of 2,033.

Returning Fall Enrollment (Reference: Table 4)

- Returning student enrollment increased nominally over last year's record high to 15,094 students, up 27 students or 0.18 percent.
- The lower class levels recorded moderate losses which were offset by gains at the senior class level.

Undergraduate Fall Enrollment (Reference: Table 5)

- Undergraduate enrollment increased slightly to a record high of 19,461 students. This represents the 11th increase in the past 12 years.
- Only the freshmen class level showed an enrollment decline.

Graduate Fall Enrollment

- Graduate enrollment fell moderately to 6,375 students, down by 266 students or 4.0 percent.
- The current year's enrollment is the lowest since the fall of 1986.

Total Fall Enrollment

- The total fall term enrollment was 25,836, down slightly by 103 students from last year's enrollment. Enrollment is currently at its third highest level. Undergraduate gains were large enough to offset the graduate losses.

Part-time Fall Enrollments (Reference: Table 6)

- The percent of undergraduate part-time students reached a low of 31.44 percent, the lowest level since 1981.
- Graduate part-time enrollments increased to 81.27 percent, up by 2.21 percentage points from last year's record low. The current percentage is within normal levels.

Evening Fall Enrollments (Reference: Table 7)

- Evening undergraduate enrollments increased over last year's record low to 1,886 -- an increase of 254 students. At 9.28 percent-of-total, it remains substantially less than the 12-13 percent range recorded in the early 1980s.
- Evening graduate enrollments increased moderately to 65.09 percent, staying within normal levels.

Citizenship Distribution - Opening Fall Term (Reference: Table 8)

- Michigan resident enrollment continues to comprise a high proportion of undergraduate enrollment, though it fell slightly from last year.
- Ohio residents increased moderately as a percent-of-total, exceeding the four percent mark for the first time.
- The greatest proportional gain came from U.S. states outside of Michigan (excluding Ohio). For the first time, this category exceeded two percent of total, up by approximately 33 percent over normal levels.
- Michigan students continue to constitute a high percentage of the graduate students. There has not been substantial growth in the non-Michigan enrollments. There are no remarkable patterns.

II. CREDIT HOUR PRODUCTION - 1991-92

Credit Hour Production by Term (Reference: Table 10)

- Overall, there is considerable stability in each term's percent-of-total credit hours, however, there is a slight decline in the proportion of credit hours taken in the spring term over the past three years, falling from 9.36 percent in 1988/89 to 8.58 in the current year.
- The fall term showed some increase in its percentage-of-total fiscal year credit hours -- negating the premise that students are shifting credit hours to non-fall terms.

Credit Hour Loads (Reference: Table 11)

- Undergraduate credit hour loads for the fall term fell moderately to 11.35 credit hours per student -- the fourth lowest mark in the past 13 years.
- Graduate credit hour production for the fall term increased to 4.93 credit hours per student -- a ten year high.
- Fiscal year credit hour loads for both graduate and undergraduate students are at a six year high -- all the data on record.
- There is a shifting of credit hours from the spring term to the summer term. In 1985/86, the summer term comprised 51 percent of the spring term. In 1991/92, the percentage had risen to 59 percent.



Full Year Equated Student

--By Course Level (Reference: Table 12)

- For 1991/92, the greatest growth in FYES occurred among upper (300 & 400) level courses (in accordance with the greater growth in upper class level enrollments.)
- Graduate FYES, for the same year, grew modestly, by 0.4 percent to the third highest on record.
- Overall, University FYES production is at the second highest level at 18,953.18, but down 0.8 percent from the prior year's record high.

--By College (Reference: Table 13)

- The College of Arts and Sciences and the College of Business recorded modest increases of less than one percent in FYES production.
- The College of Health and Human Services registered the largest percentage gain with nearly a four percent increase.
- The College of Education fell by 6.7 percent in 1991/92, bringing the College's FYES to 3,060 -- a four year low.
- The College of Technology recorded a 4.1 percent loss to 818 FYES, the lowest level since 1984/85.
