Normajeane Anderson Graduate Award

Normajeane Anderson, associate professor emerita in the Department of Business and Industrial Education, recently established a scholarship for business education students.

The \$3,000 endowed fund will provide a \$250 annual award to an outstanding graduate student currently enrolled in the master's of business education program at EMU. The student must have completed 15 hours of graduate work, with a minimum of six hours of business education courses. The student also must have maintained a minimum 3.5 cumulative grade point average.

The award recipient each year will be chosen by a panel of members of the Gamma Alpha chapter of Delta Pi Epsilon honorary society.
