## **Clerical/Secretarial Employees Settle**

The Board of Regents approved a labor agreement with UAW Local 1975 representing clerical and secretarial employees at its regular monthly meeting May 21. The agreement includes a 13 percent salary increase effective July 1, 1980, up to a \$300 bonus, a dental insurance program and three paid holidays between Christmas and New Years among other provisions.

## **Doctoral Degree Programs Discussed**

The Board of Regents discussed the development of doctoral degree programs in educational leadership, clinical psychology and school psychology at its May 21 meeting.

## **Intramural Building Costs Inflate, Regents Told**

The Regents were informed at this May 21 meeting that the costs of the proposed building of a campus recreational/intramural facility and renovations to the existing athletic building have jumped from an estimated \$14.3 to \$15.5 million. If the construction contracts and bonding arrangements are approved by the Regents this summer, construction will begin Sept. 2.

## **Bilingual Grant Tops List**

Twelve educational grants totaling \$1.6 million, including six new grants, were accepted by the Board of Regents at its May 21 meeting. A \$162,800 grant to fund EMU's Bilingual Vocational Education Instructor Training Program topped the list of new grants.

## **New Program Approved**

The Regents approved a program leading to a master's degree in Teaching English as a Second Language at their May 21 meeting.

## **Kajcienski Is Admissions Director**

Donald Kajcienski, associate director of admissions, was promoted to director of admissions by the Regents at their May 21 meeting. Kajcienski, an Ypsilanti resident, has been with the University since 1976.

## **Patrick Appointed Management Head**

Dr. Floyd A. Patrick, acting head of the Department of Management since 1978, was appointed head of the department by the Regents at their May meeting. Patrick joined the EMU faculty as a professor in 1970.

## **Regents Accept \$163,700 in Gifts**

The EMU Regents accepted gifts and bequests for the months of January through April totaling \$163,700 at their May 21 meeting. The gift figure accepted by the Regents represents a \$31,700 increase compared to gifts received during the same period last year.
