The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p. m.

. 561 M - GENERAL FUND BUDGET 1967-68

Mr. Lawrence moved and Dr. Anspach seconded that the General Fund Budget for 1967-68, as distributed at the June 26 meeting, be approved as amended. Carried.

A communication from James Raphael, President of the Student Council, was read by Mr. McCormick and copies distributed to the Board.

. 562 M - SALARIES FOR 1967-68

Mr. Lawrence moved and Dr. O'Hara seconded that the proposed 1967-68 salaries for Eastern Michigan University faculty and staff, distributed at the June 26, 1967, meeting of the Board, be approved as amended. Carried.

. 563 M - RATES CHANGED

Mr. Lawrence moved and Mr. Habel seconded that the following changes in rates, effective with the fall semester, 1967, be approved:

1. Board and Room in Residence Halls:

\$894.00 per year
\$447.00 per semester

2. Student Apartment Rates:

One bedroom - \$ 85.00 per month
Two bedroom - \$100.00 per month

.565 M - TUITION RATES CHANGED

Mr. Lawrence moved and Mr. Habel seconded that the following list of changes in tuition rates, effective with the fall semester 1967, be approved:

Registration Fee:

All students are required to pay a non-refundable fee of \$15.00 per semester. This fee is collected when the student pays his tuition.

.566 M - PARKING REGULATION CHANGES

Mr. Lawrence moved and Mr. Husse seconded that the following changes in parking regulations be approved, effective with the fall semester 1967:

1. The parking meter rate be increased to 5¢ per hour from the present 5¢ per two hours.
2. The fine for prohibited zone or restricted zone parking be increased from \$2.00 to \$3.00.
3. A campus bus route between West Campus, North Campus and Central Campus be implemented at a fare of 10¢.

It is further recommended that this be funded as an auxiliary fund program.

.567 M - AUXILIARY FUND BUDGET

Mr. Lawrence moved and Mr. Husse seconded that the proposed Auxiliary Fund Budget for Revenue Bond Projects (Residence Halls and Food Service) and the Proposed Auxiliary Fund Budget for Non-Self-Liquidating Operations (Internal Service) as distributed at the June 26, 1967, meeting of the Board be approved.
