## **A Brief Look at EMU's December 2005 Graduation Ceremony**

Eastern Michigan University has more than 24,000 students. It offers two commencement ceremonies in April and one in December.

All five of the University's colleges participate. They are the College of Arts and Sciences; the College of Business; the College of Education; the College of Health and Human Services; and the College of Technology.

Ceremonies were originally in Bowen Field House, which was only 88,923 square feet. The Convocation Center, which is 200,000 square feet, opened in 1998. It can hold up to 9,300 persons for concerts and other events.

This year's 2 p.m. ceremony will honor graduates from all five colleges.
